**ACTIVITY REPORT
OCTOBER 2022 TO NOVEMBER 2022**

The NPS has been delivering regular policing services since April 1, 1996. Created in accordance with the spirit of the *James Bay and Northern Québec Agreement (JBNQA)* and pursuant to sections 369 and 370 of the *Act respecting Northern Villages and the Kativik Regional Government*, the NPS's mission is to maintain peace, order and public safety, prevent and suppress crime and infractions under the laws and regulations applicable in that territory and apprehend offenders.

Human Resources

Since October 1:

- Nineteen (19) people were hired as new probationary police employees;
- Six (6) members resigned;

Training

- Deputy Chief Shaun Longstreet and Captain Maxime Mercier completed the *Integration activity in police management* course provided by the ENPQ.

Policing Services in Nunavik

Considering difficulties with recruiting during the pandemic (ENPQ operating at reduced capacity), the NPS requested assistance from the *Sûreté du Québec* (SQ, provincial police) in March 2021; Currently, eighteen (18) SQ officers are deployed in the region at least until the summer of 2023.

The NPS continues to be very proactive in its recruiting strategies.

Enhanced patrols

The NPS has implemented various methods to increase patrols and visibility throughout the 14 northern villages. For example, captains can now track the number of kilometers officers patrolled on every shift, allowing them to take corrective measures if there are not enough patrols. Discussions were also held with the SQ to get their collaboration to increase their patrols.

Visits with mayors and community leaders

Working with the NPS training officers, the NPS is developing, as part of onboarding new NPS members, a method to follow up with the new members after they leave Kuujuaq and arrive at their assigned community. In addition, the training officers will ensure that the new officers introduce themselves to the mayor, councillors and community leaders.

In addition, the division captains are now responsible for scheduling a monthly meeting between an NPS officer and the mayor of each community. The goal is to enhance the communication between elected officials and local police officers. The sessions will allow the elected officials to inform the local police officers of the NV's preoccupations.

Regional Mixed Investigations Team (NPS-SQ)

Since its creation last year, the team has conducted multiple investigations and drug and alcohol operations, resulting in multiple seizures. These numbers are included in the statistics.

The team has proven to be very effective in improving the response time of investigators deployed on major event investigations. Investigators from the mixed unit have been involved in hundreds of criminal investigations since the beginning of the year, removing a considerable workload from the patrol officers.

September highlights:

- In Salluit, the team executed a search warrant under the Act respecting offences relating to alcoholic beverages.

October highlights:

- In Kuujuaq, the team executed a search warrant in two dwelling-houses. Police officers seized 130 grams of cocaine, 560 methamphetamine pills and two (2) prohibited firearms. In addition, a pick-up truck was seized as an offence-related property (proceeds of crime). Following the execution of the warrant, a 26-year-old male was arrested and charged with

drug trafficking. His accomplice was arrested and released with a promise to appear. A third party was arrested and released without accusation.

- In Kuujjuaq, the team executed a search warrant in two dwelling-houses. Police officers seized 2034 pills of methamphetamine, about 5,000\$ in cash, electronic devices, scales, and paraphernalia. Two suspects were arrested and released with a promise to appear.

Gun Safety Cabinets

In partnership with the Kativik Municipal Housing Bureau (KMHB), the prevention team distributed gun safety cabinets to encourage the safe storage of firearms in Nunavik houses. More cabinets were distributed in Kangiqsujaq.

MADD National Memorial

Every year, MADD Canada hosts its National Conference for Victims of Impaired Driving where almost 300 delegates from across Canada come together to share their experiences and honour those killed or injured due to impaired driving.

From September 23 to 25, prevention officer Jeff Heron represented the NPS at the conference. Cst. Heron established new relationships with stakeholders around the country.

Community Visits

These visits are done in communities where supervisors are not based permanently. The purpose is to meet with the police officers, elected officials, and partners in the community. Supervisors travelled to the following communities:
