**ACTIVITY REPORT
JUNE 2023 TO SEPTEMBER 2023**

The NPS has been delivering regular policing services since April 1, 1996. Created in accordance with the spirit of the *James Bay and Northern Québec Agreement (JBNQA)* and pursuant to sections 369 and 370 of the *Act respecting Northern Villages and the Kativik Regional Government*, the NPS's mission is to maintain peace, order and public safety, prevent and suppress crime and infractions under the laws and regulations applicable in that territory and apprehend offenders.

Human Resources

Since June 1:

- Cst. Tyler MacDonald has been appointed as a Prevention Officer, based in Kuujuaq;
- Twelve (12) individuals were hired as new probationary police employees;
- Four (4) individuals were hired as student employees and have started their training at the RCMP's police academy;
- One (1) temporary police employee has been hired;
- Two (2) members have resigned, one (1) member's temporary contract has concluded, and one (1) member's employment was terminated because they did not pass their probation.
- Eleven (7) students graduated from RCMP's police academy and started working in Nunavik.

Policing Services in Nunavik

Due to the difficulties with recruiting since the pandemic, the NPS requested assistance from the Sûreté du Québec (SQ, provincial police) in March 2021; Currently, twenty-two (22) SQ officers are deployed in the region at least until the end of 2023. The NPS remains proactive in its recruiting strategies. We were able to lower considerably the number of SQ officers thanks to the numerous hires in the last few months.

RCMP Depot Division

One of the NPS's recruiting strategies is to recruit people without police studies but with valuable life experience and to send them to the RCMP's police academy in Regina for six (6) months.

Currently, eleven (11) graduates have begun their roles as police officers in Nunavik. There are eighteen (18) individuals currently in training, seven (7) have finished the selection process and will begin in the coming weeks, and thirty-two (32) others are in the application process.

Training

June highlights:

- Five (5) members received the *Carbine – AR Platform* training (ENPQ).
- Cst. Louis-Pierre Levesque provided annual weapons and intermediary weapons recertification training to members based in Salluit and Puvirnituk.

August highlights:

- Cst. Louis-Pierre Levesque provided annual weapons and intermediary weapons recertification training to members based in Kuujuaq.

Regional Emergency Call Centre (RECC)

In March, the Regional Emergency Call Centre began handling emergency calls for Umiujaq. In May, Kuujuaaraapik was added to the service. On July 11, the RECC extended its services to include emergency calls for Puvirnituk. Inukjuak is scheduled to be added in September.

Between March and July, the call centre answered a total of 1,200 calls from citizens.

Prevention

In August and September, the prevention team hosted bike rallies in Ivujivik, Kangiqsujaq, Aupaluk and Puvirnituk. A BBQ lunch was hosted, and various activities were organized. Local organizations helped and contributed to make these events possible. In total, the NPS gave over one hundred (100) bicycles.

Regional Mixed Investigations Team (NPS-SQ)

Since its creation, the Regional Mixed Investigations Team (NPS-SQ) has successfully executed numerous investigations and substance control operations, leading to a significant number of drug and alcohol seizures. These results are incorporated into the statistics.

The team has proven to be very effective in improving the response time of investigators deployed on major event investigations. Investigators from the mixed unit have been involved in many criminal investigations since the beginning of the year, removing a considerable workload from the patrol officers.

July highlights:

- In partnership with the RCMP, an operation was conducted at the Canada Post facility in Montreal. Throughout the week, numerous illegal parcels containing drugs and alcohol were seized. Over one hundred and fifteen (115) parcels were destined for Nunavik were confiscated. The total seizures included:
 - 1,002 bottles of 375 ml hard liquor;
 - 9 kilograms of cannabis;
 - 4 grams of cocaine;
 - 30 grams of methamphetamines;
 - 340 grams of mushrooms;
 - 692 grams of hashish;
 - 1,100 edibles (cannabis);
 - 82 joints (cannabis);
 - 1,800 cigarettes

This successful operation resulted in the seizure of over \$490,000 worth of black-market contraband.

August highlights:

- In Salluit, the NPS officers and the SQ officers executed two (2) search warrants and seized 19 g of crack and 83 g of cocaine and thirteen (13) bottles of 375 ml hard liquor.
