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## Why summer activities are essential?

- They help address what educators refer to as “summer learning loss.
- Ensure Nunavimmiut youth have some of the same opportunities as their peers across the province.
- Support parents and caregivers by offering full-day activities in a safe environment.



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## A new approach for summer 2025!

- A hybrid model that integrates literacy in NV activities.
- Multidisciplinary activities with focus on literacy.
- Concentrate most of our activities during a specific timeline & location (June 16<sup>th</sup> to July 11<sup>th</sup>).

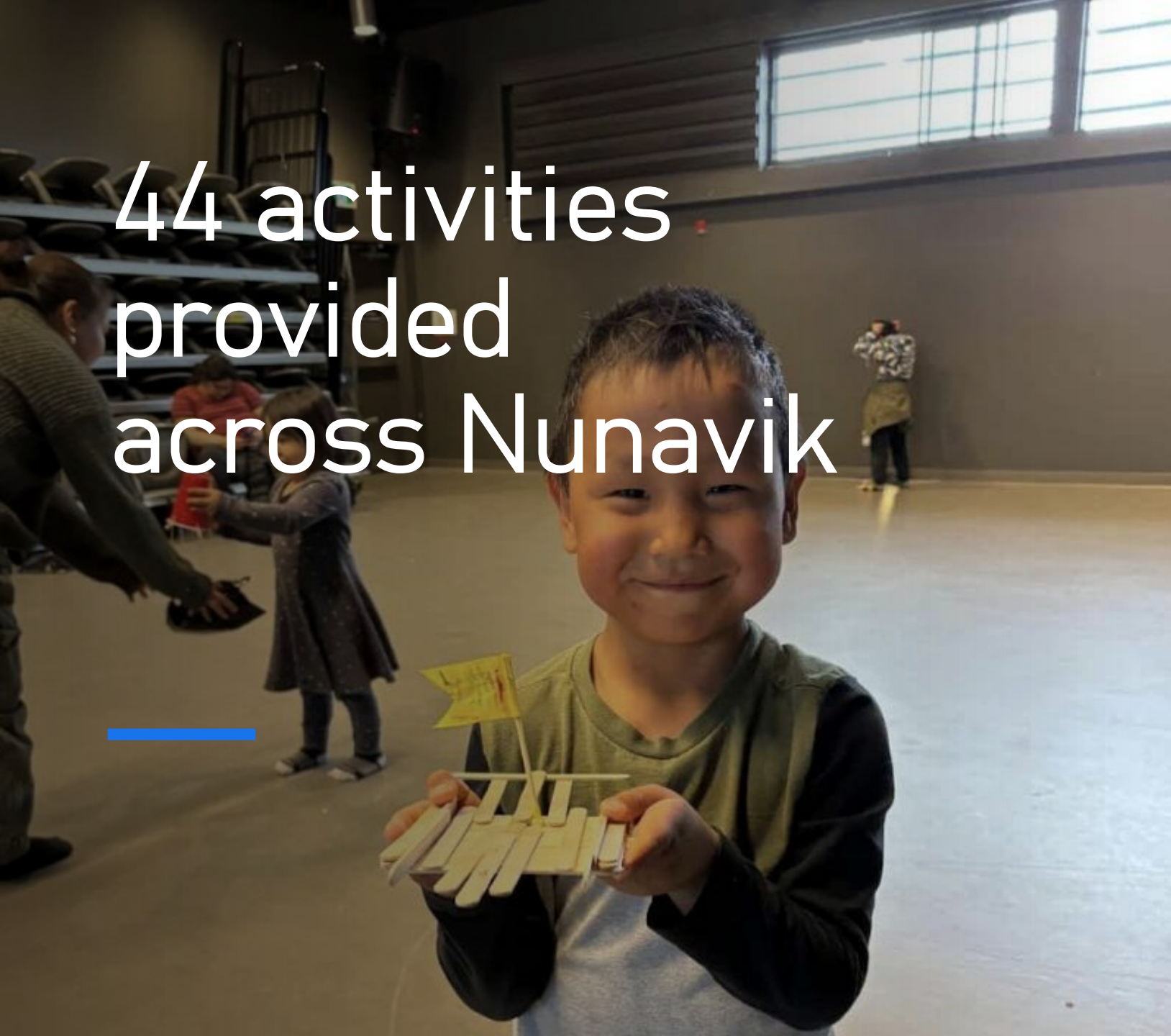
# This allowed us to...

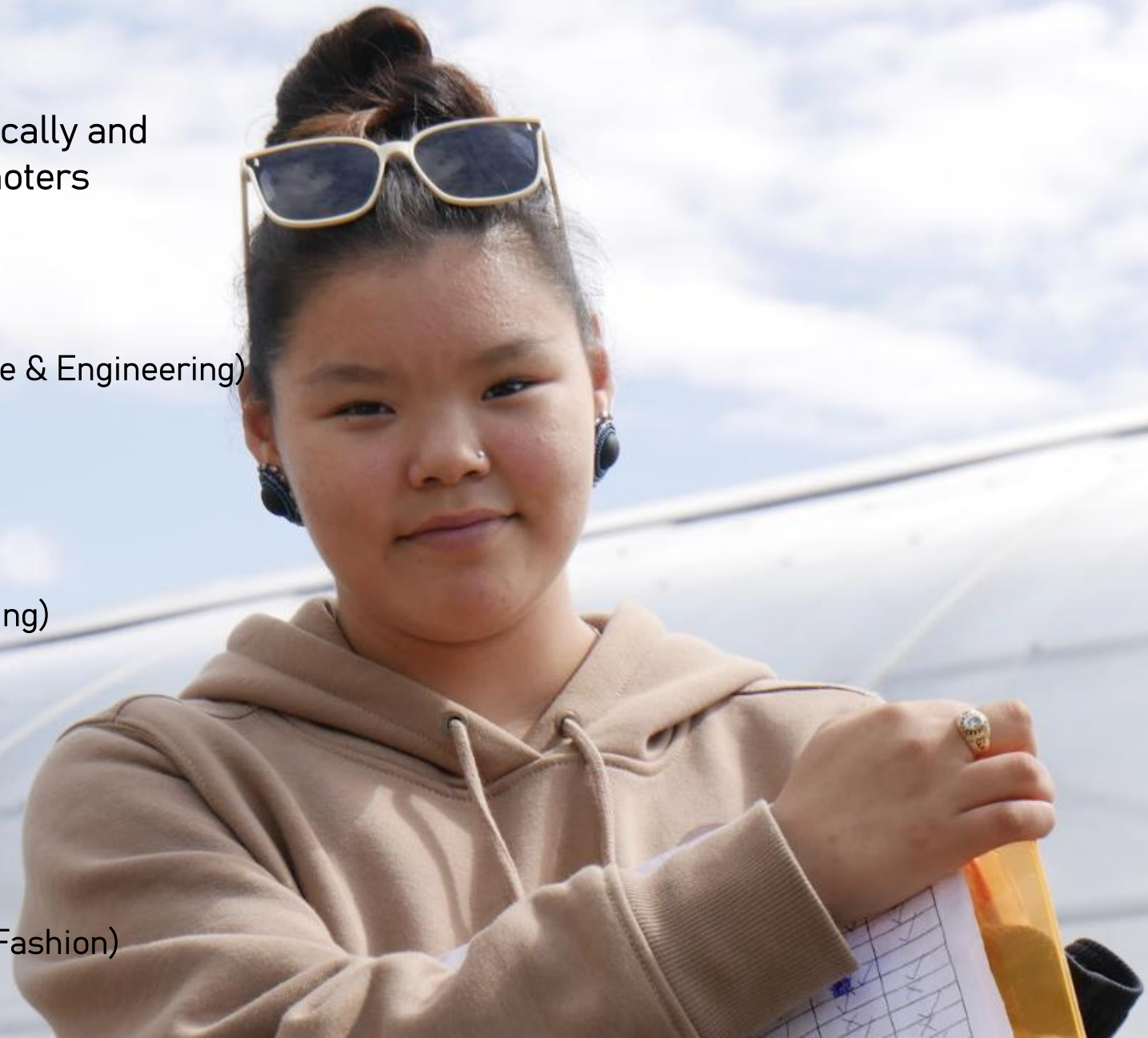
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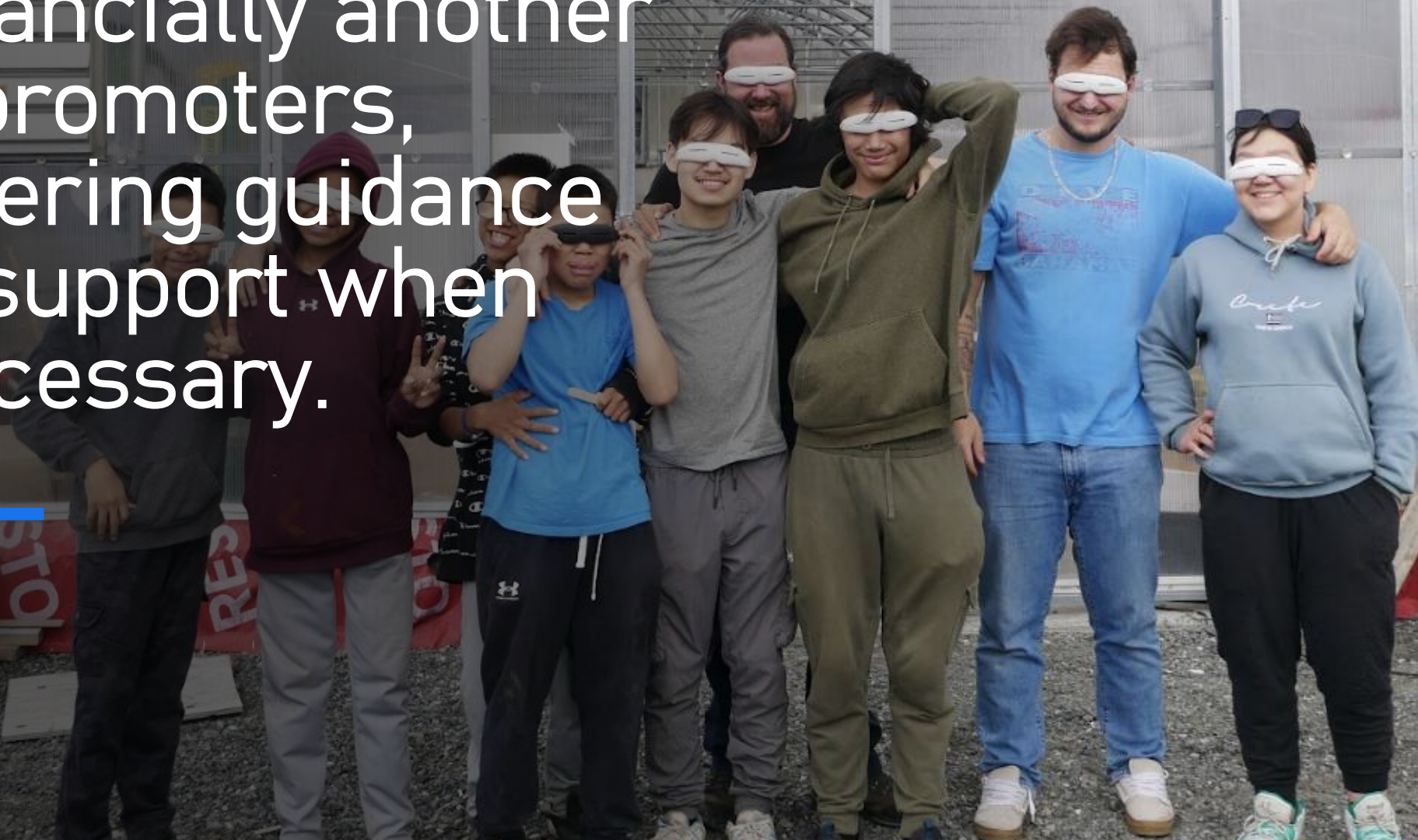
# Our Activities

We supported both logistically and financially 9 activity promoters

- CNCB (Biking)
- Folie Technique (Science & Engineering)

# Challenges

- On the land policies & guidelines.
- Service offer limitations due to space and renovations.
- Not enough activities in larger communities.
- Recruiting participants in the 13 to 17 years old age gap.
- Securing lodging, although a noted improvement over last year, thanks to school transits.
- While there were improvements, collecting insights from participants and families remains challenging.
- Overall costs.
- Lack of local promoters.

# Highlights

- More than # youth participated in new & exciting discoveries.
- Family inclusive activities.
- Through our collaboration with United for Literacy, we were able to provide more onsite training for our local staff members.
- ESUMA provided a mandatory Cultural Awareness online training offered by Laina Grey for promoters coming from the south.
- % of our activities were run in part or fully by Indigenous and/or Inuit.
- We worked alongside 3 Universities; Concordia, Polytechnique, and Laval University.
- Culturally relevant and appropriate materials provided.
- At least one camp activity per village.
- Well-balanced mix of indoor and outdoor activities.
- Connections were made beyond activities we funded/organized. Promoters financed by other orgs integrated our baseline activities, identifying a willingness for collaboration and working towards a common goal.
- Provided food security.
- Collaboration within KRG departments , notably the Communications & Travel Departments.
