**ACTIVITY REPORT  
NOVEMBER 2022 TO FEBRUARY 2023**

The NPS has been delivering regular policing services since April 1, 1996. Created in accordance with the spirit of the *James Bay and Northern Québec Agreement (JBNQA)* and pursuant to sections 369 and 370 of the *Act respecting Northern Villages and the Kativik Regional Government*, the NPS's mission is to maintain peace, order and public safety, prevent and suppress crime and infractions under the laws and regulations applicable in that territory and apprehend offenders.

**Human Resources**

Since November 1:

- Sarah Bastille-Thériault and Olivier Blanchette were appointed as Sergeants. Sgt. Bastille-Thériault will work out of Salluit and Sgt. Blanchette out of Kuujuaq.
- Seven (7) people were hired as new probationary police employees and five (5) of them were hired to go follow the training with the RCMP in Regina;
- Three (3) people were hired as temporary police employees;
- Six (6) members resigned;

## **Policing Services in Nunavik**

Considering difficulties with recruiting during the pandemic (ENPQ operating at reduced capacity), the NPS requested assistance from the *Sûreté du Québec* (SQ, provincial police) in March 2021; Currently, twenty-nine (29) SQ officers are deployed in the region at least until the end of 2023.

The NPS continues to be very proactive in its recruiting strategies.

## **RCMP Depot Division**

One of the NPS's recruiting strategies is to recruit people without police studies but with a good life experience and to send them to the RCMP's police academy in Regina for six (6) months.

Six months ago, the NPS hired the first two (2) candidates to follow and complete the full training that the RCMP gives to all of its officers in Regina. On January 16, Captain Mathieu Savage attended their graduation ceremony. They will arrive in Nunavik on February 1.

Currently, nine (9) candidates are at the RCMP's police academy and seven (7) candidates will begin their training in the coming weeks. There are thirty-two (32) applicants that are currently in the NPS application process.

## **Training**

- At the end of October, Sergeant Matthew Turner and Sergeant Marc-Olivier Duclos completed the patrol supervision training provided by the ENPQ.
- In November, six (6) patrol sergeants received training on the *Act respecting offences relating to alcoholic beverages* (LIMBA). The training, delivered by the SQ's contraband unit, aims to help the officers in the communities to understand better their powers and to have a better knowledge in regards to the liquor act. The main goal of this training was for the officers to be able to seize more alcohol that is illegally obtained through bootleggers.
- In December, Cst. Louis-Pierre Lévesque attended and completed a Colt armourer training delivered by Colt Canada.
- Between November and January, in collaboration with KRG and KI, CPR and first aid training were given to recertify police officers in Kangiqsujuaq, Ivujivik, Kangirsuk, Kuujjuaq, Inukjuak, Puvirnituq and Umiujaq. This training will be given to police officers in the remaining communities in the coming months.
- In January, Cst. Louis-Pierre Levesque travelled to Kuujjuaraapik to provide annual weapon and intermediary weapon recertification training.

## **Regional Emergency Call Centre (RECC)**

In December, Chief Jean-Pierre Larose, Deputy Chief Shaun Longstreet, Senior Advisor Benoit Plante, Saint-Eustache Police Chief Thierry Vallières and the emergency call centre coordinator Mrs. Vicky Gionet visited Kuujjuaraapik, Umiujaq and Puvirnituq to meet with the municipal councils and to present the emergency call centre project. The project is scheduled to begin in March.

## **Regional Mixed Investigations Team (NPS-SQ)**

Since its creation last year, the team has conducted multiple investigations and drug and alcohol operations, resulting in multiple seizures. These numbers are included in the statistics.

The team has proven to be very effective in improving the response time of investigators deployed on major event investigations. Investigators from the mixed unit have been involved in many criminal investigations since the beginning of the year, removing a considerable workload from the patrol officers.

January highlights:

- The team composed of NPS investigators and SQ investigators did a simultaneous drug operation in Kuujuaq and Saint-Gabriel-de-Brandon. This operation led to the arrest of two (2) individuals and led to the following seizures:
  - 110g of cocaine
  - 3 lbs of marijuana
  - 300 pills of methamphetamine
  - 10g of psilocybin
  - 21 050\$ in Canadian currency
  - Items related to the traffic of cocaine
  - Safe

During this conference, Cst Heron obtained useful prevention material to do some impaired driving presentations in the high schools in the region.

These visits are done in communities where supervisors are not based permanently. The purpose is to meet with the local police officers, elected officials, and partners in the community. Supervisors travelled to the following communities:
