APPLICATION/SOFTWARE SPECIALIST (TEMPORARY, FULL-TIME POSITION)

Under the supervision of the Assistant Director – Information Technology section – The Application/Software Specialist is responsible for:

- Design, maintain and implement database management systems, computer applications and operating systems;
- Analyze organizational software needs, devise solutions and maintain PC software and hardware systems;
- Reviews and analyzes organization business needs; confers with users to evaluate requirements, discuss solutions and develop plan of approach;
- Analyzes and designs program logic, screen layouts, reports, station criteria and testing criteria to support development of new or enhanced systems;
- Performs all aspects of systems design including writing required programs, testing and evaluation of new processes and implementation of new applications;
- Prepares program documentation to support new or enhanced systems and applications along with implementing system failure and recovery procedures;
- Conducts or coordinates user acceptance, performance stress, regression and integration testing, makes changes and corrections as needed;
- Participates in structured walk-throughs and other activities to review systems;
- Performs ongoing maintenance and review of applications systems and programs; identifies problems and develops appropriate solutions;
- Where necessary, provide guidance to KRG users including training, mentoring and support;
- Perform other related duties as required by the supervisor.
