Reporting to the Assistant Director Airport Administration, Transportation Department, the Coordinator Infrastructure and Special Projects is responsible for the organization and monitoring of Airport Infrastructures, Marine Ports, Mobile Equipment and Associated Capital and Improvement Projects. The following description of work describes but is not limited to the responsibilities of the position:
