



Three Kangirsuk Residents Arrested for Illegal Possession of Drugs and Alcohol

Police searched a home in Kangirsuk last Friday, which resulted in the seizure of drugs, alcohol and cash.

Two men and a woman were arrested after police searched a residence and found various quantities of cocaine, methamphetamine, marijuana and cannabis oil. The individuals face drug possession charges as well as possible charges for the illegal possession and sale of alcohol.

The Integrated Nunavik Investigative Team made-up of Sûreté du Québec and Nunavik Police Service investigators conducted the search where they also found and seized \$43,515.00 in cash along with electronic devices.

The three individuals were arrested after being interrogated by police. They were later released and will be summoned to appear in court to be formally charged. The identities of the individuals are being withheld until the Crown prosecutor examines the file to determine what formal charges will be laid.
