“A Celebration of Growth and Opportunity” – KRG announces reopening of YES Nunavik Client Service Centre

Kuujuuaq, Quebec, February 6, 2025 — The Kativik Regional Government (KRG) today announces the official rededication and reopening of the YES Nunavik client service centre.

Featuring new and expanded services, a broader mandate, and a new, convenient location within the KRG main building, YES Nunavik is now positioned to better serve Nunavimmiut than ever before.

The YES Nunavik Client Service Centre is now located in the Sustainable Employment Department (SED) on the 1st floor of the KRG main building in Kuujuuaq.

This move is designed to better integrate YES Nunavik’s services within other SED initiatives, notably Services Nunavik. It is also a step forward to making sure every community member – regardless of age – has access to a suite of tailored programs and services designed to meet their employability and educational needs. Notably, the new office space features:

- job-search stations equipped with tools for job searching, resume building, and digital skills training
- a private, welcoming environment for personalized career support

These changes mark an exciting new chapter for YES Nunavik, reflecting the KRG’s commitment to supporting Nunavimmiut with accessible, innovative, and personalized services to help them achieve career and personal goals.

The SED is holding an all-day open house on Friday, February 21st to celebrate the reopening of YES Nunavik’s client services. Visitors will receive guided tours of the newly equipped office, job-search stations and new service features. The open house also features prize give-aways for visitors who book and attend a service appointment for a YES Nunavik service such as resume building, job search assistance, or interview preparation.

Throughout the week of February 17-21, radio announcements will be broadcast in all communities, and YES Nunavik Facebook and Instagram pages will share details on the YES Nunavik reopening.
