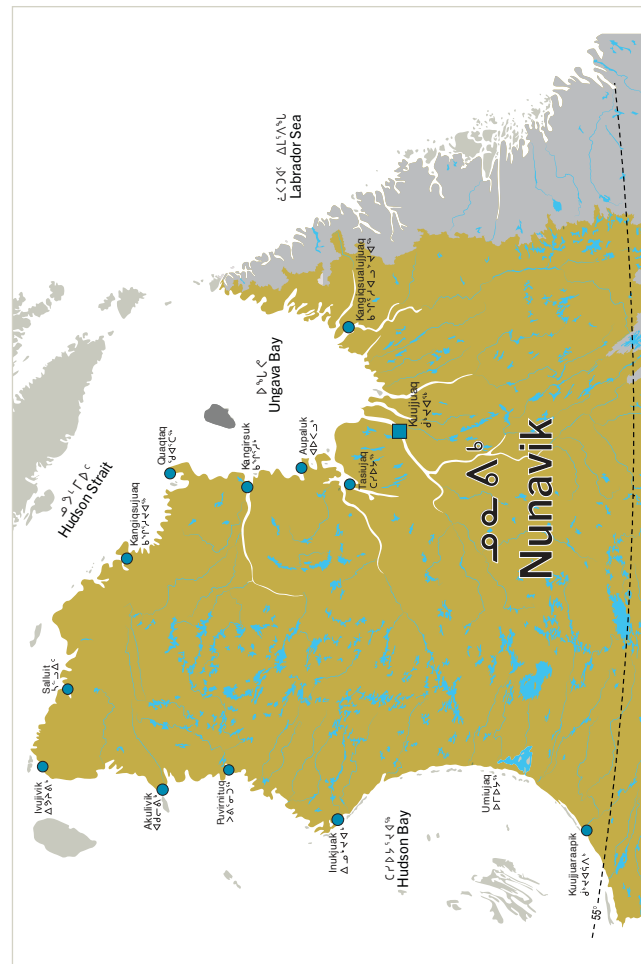

Foreword

Nunavik in Figures 2025 has been produced in order to make key statistical data on the northernmost region of Québec easily and widely accessible. The publication provides a summary socioeconomic portrait of the population and living conditions. Its content is extracted in large part from the Nunivaat databank, a core component of the Nunavik Statistics Program. The Program was established in 2005 at the request of the Kativik Regional Government to document demographic, social and economic conditions in Nunavik, as well as related trends and priority issues.

The main data sources for this publication are Statistics Canada and a few Nunavik organizations. Some content represents original research performed by Nunivaat. The data used for *Nunavik in Figures 2025* was the most recent available at the time of publication. Most of the data is also available in table format on the Nunivaat website. Detailed source information for each table is provided in *Nunavik in Figures 2025 – List of Sources* posted on the Nunivaat website.

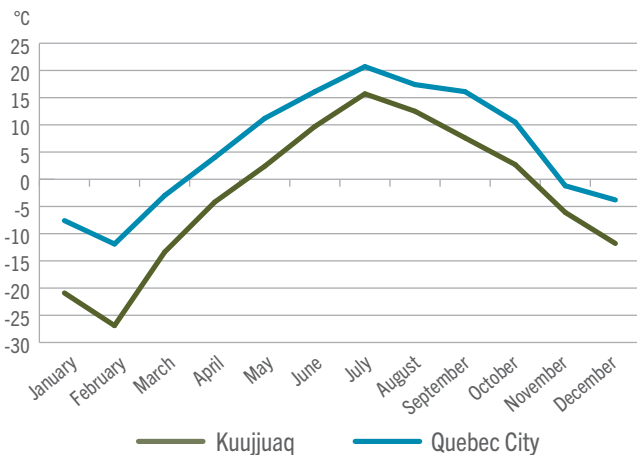

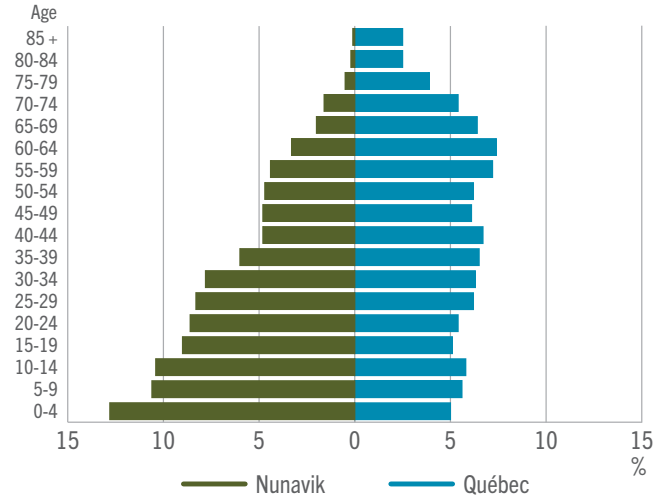

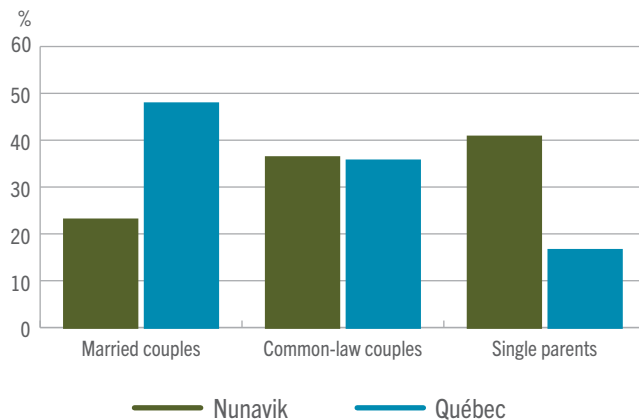

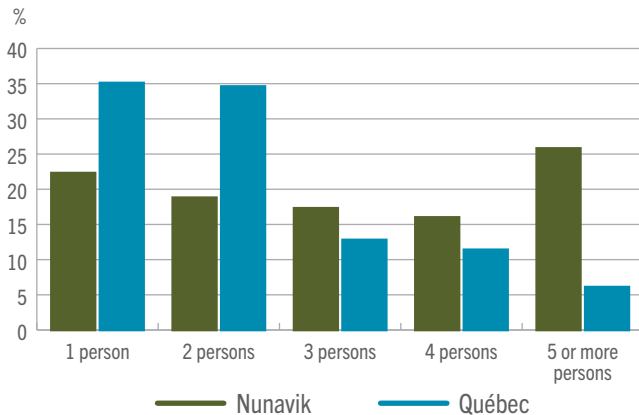

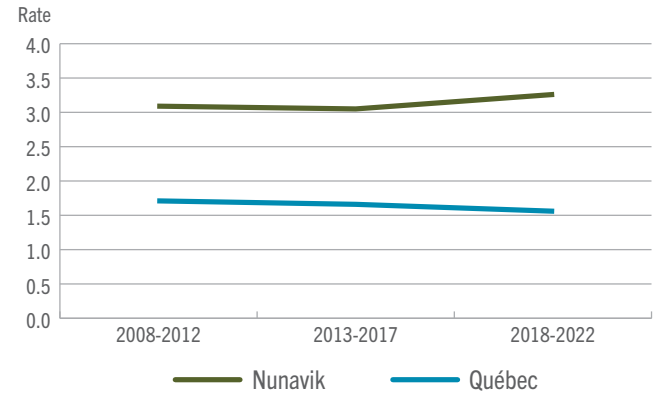

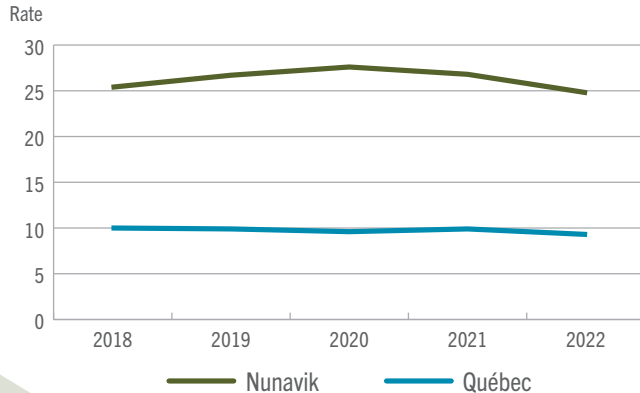

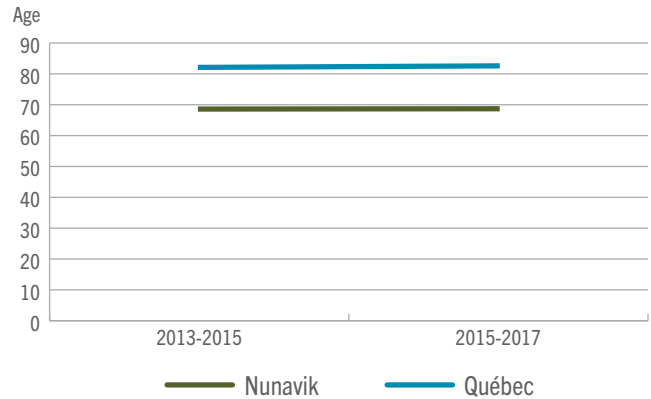

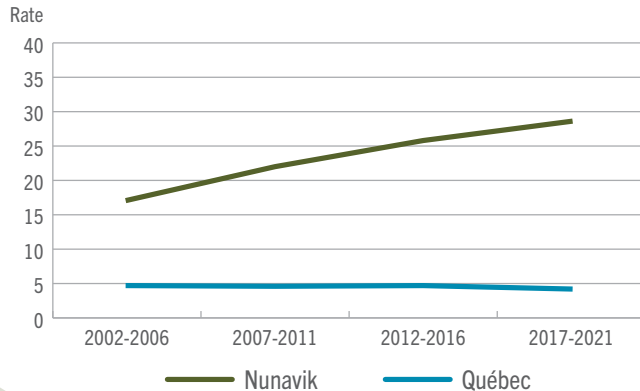

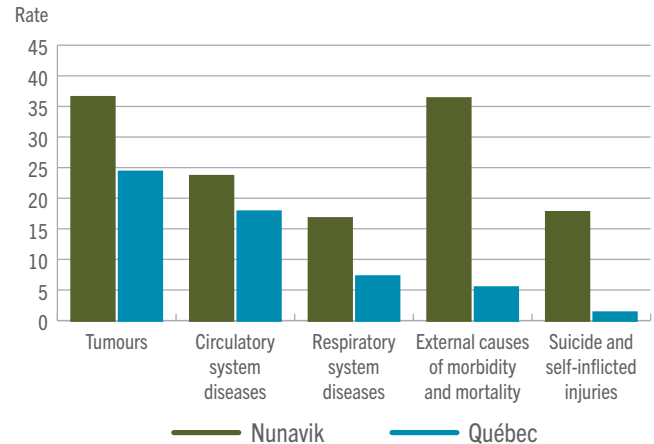

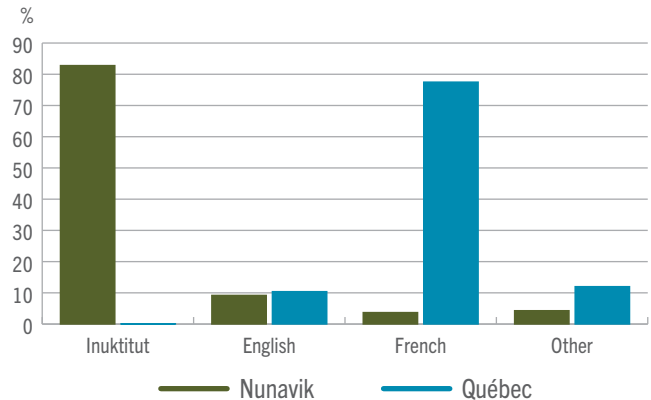

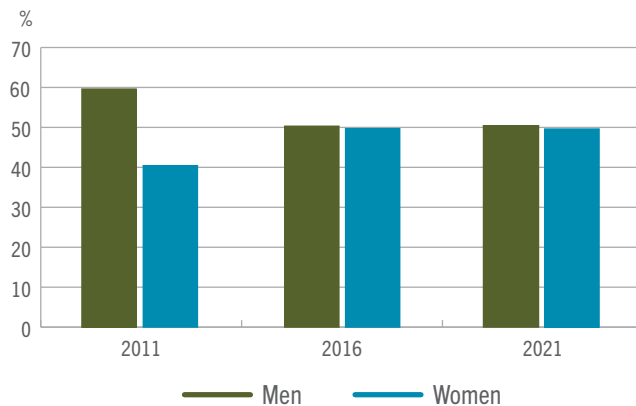

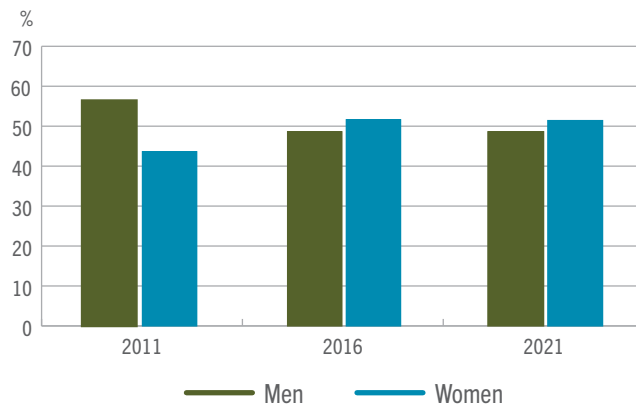

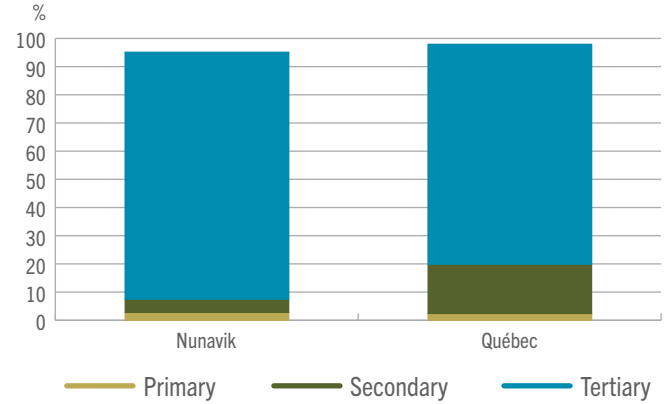

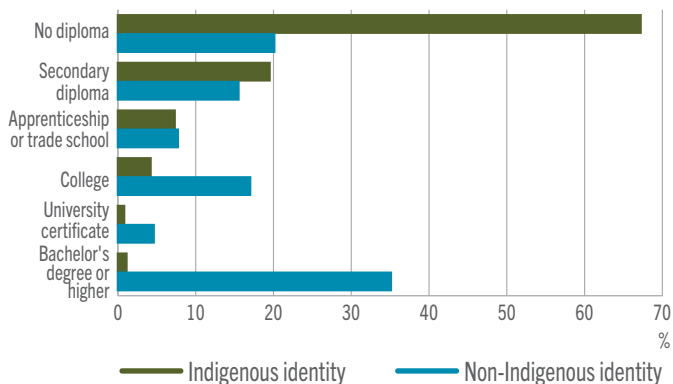

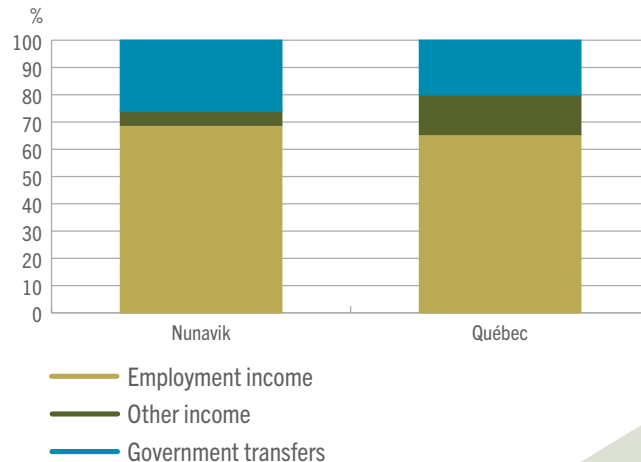

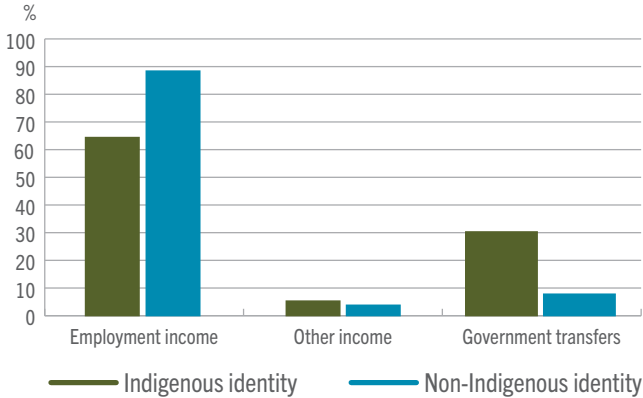

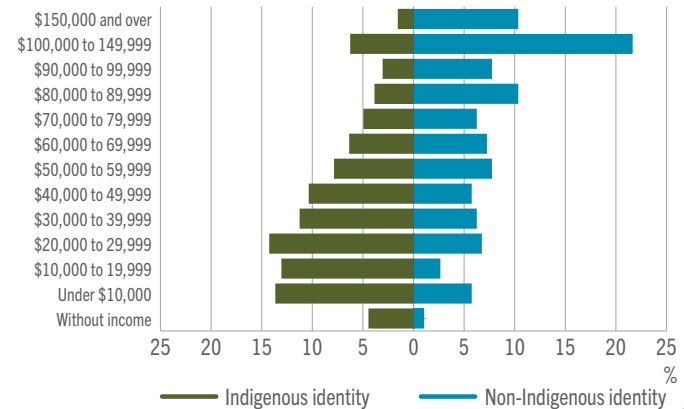

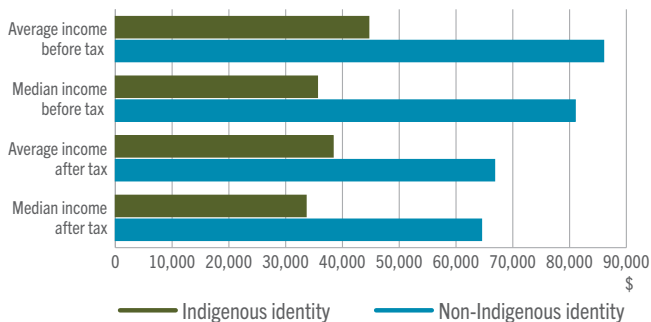

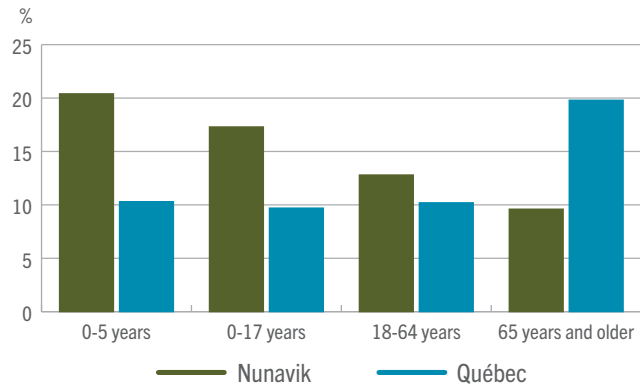

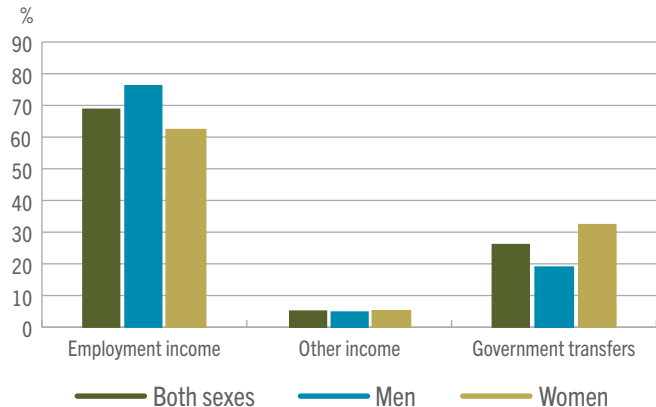

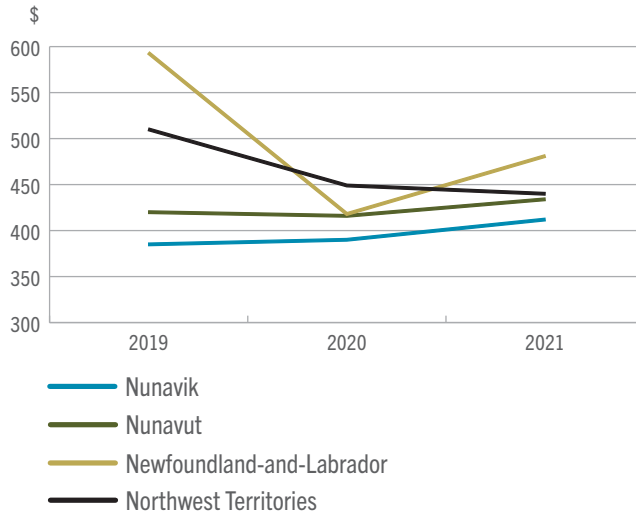

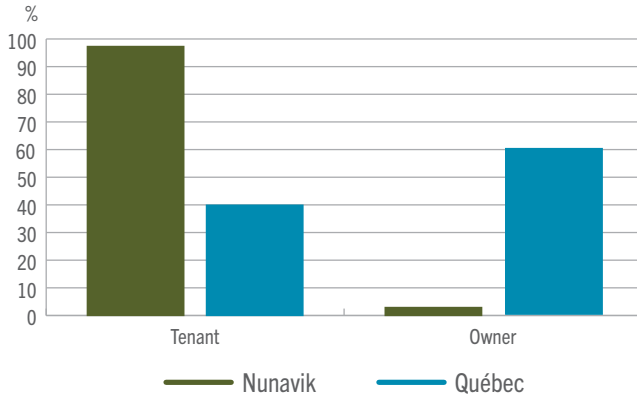

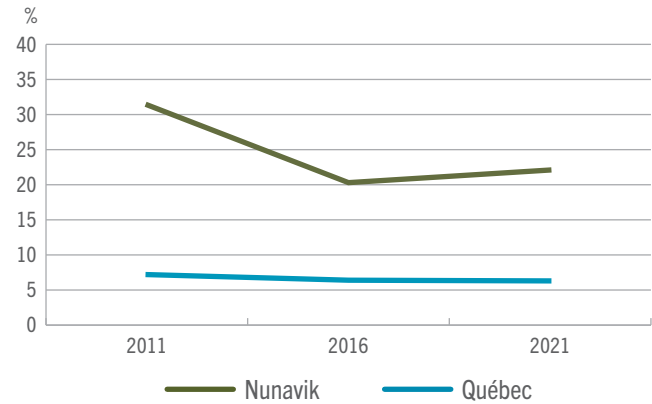

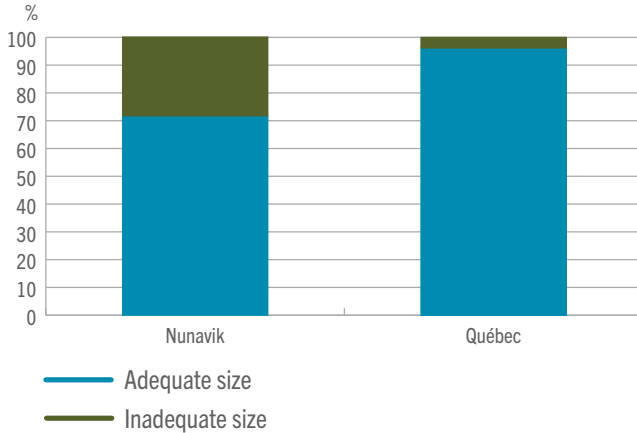

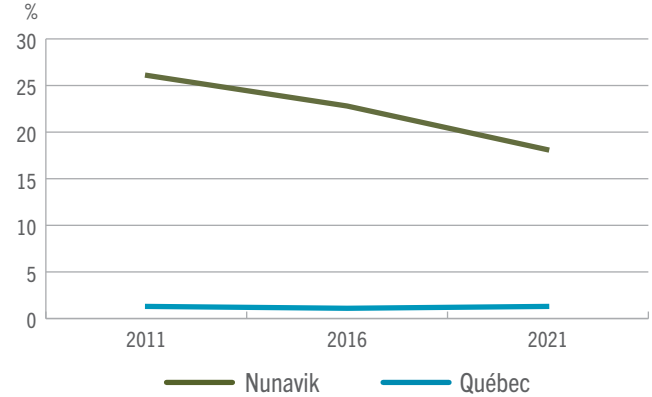

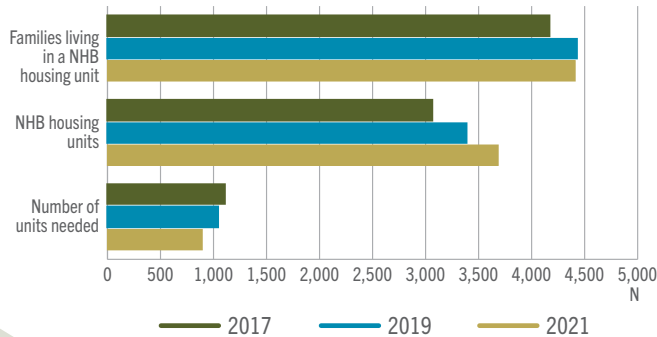
