In August 2001, the Kativik Regional Government (KRG) established the Offence Management Bureau. It is operated by the KRG Legal, Socio-Judicial and Municipal Management Department. The Offence Management Bureau supervises all procedures related to the enforcement of municipal by-laws.

By-law enforcement officers, who are municipal employees, help with the enforcement of municipal by-laws, assist in the management of the Offence Management Bureau, raise awareness about municipal by-laws, and promote offence prevention in their communities.



▶ I have been accused of breaching a municipal by-law, what do I do?

You have three options:

- Plead guilty and pay the fine;
- Plead not guilty;
- Fail to enter a plea and be required to pay the fine.

▶ I want to plead guilty to the offence. Where and how can I pay my fine?

You can pay your fine to the northern village where the offence was committed or at any municipal office in Nunavik. You can pay your fine in full (or, if arranged with the northern village, in instalments) by cash (Canadian funds), certified cheque or postal money order. As required by the law, additional costs or contributions may be payable with the fine.

▶ Where does the money collected through fines go?

All fines collected for offence to municipal by-laws are transferred to the northern village where the statement of offence (ticket) was issued.

A by-law enforcement officer or police officer serves a statement of offence to the person who committed the offence against the municipal by-law.

FAILURE TO ENTER A PLEA

The defendant accepts that he committed the offence described in the statement of offence and wants to plead guilty:

- A guilty plea is entered on the plea form;
- The plea form with payment is delivered to the northern village;
- A defendant who pleads guilty and pays the total amount (fine and other applicable costs) is deemed to have been convicted of the offence.

The defendant does not accept that he committed the offence described in the statement of offence, wants to present his version of the event, and does not want to plead guilty:

- A not-guilty plea is entered on the plea form;
- The plea form is transmitted to the Offence Management Bureau;
- The case is transferred to court for trial;
- Notification of the scheduled court hearing is transmitted to the defendant;
- At the trial, the prosecutor presents the facts appearing in the statement of offence and the defendant presents his defence;
- The judge renders a verdict of guilty or not-guilty.

The defendant fails to enter a plea or to pay the fine within 30 days:

- The defendant is deemed to have pleaded not guilty and his case is heard in his absence by a judge in court without further notice;
- If the defendant is convicted by default, a notice of judgement for the amount of the fine is transmitted to the defendant. Additional costs may also be imposed.

Notice of judgement: Guilty verdict

- A defendant found guilty of an offence must transmit his payment to the Fine Collector.
- If a defendant is unable to pay the fine immediately on receipt of the notice of judgement, the Fine Collector may enter into an agreement with the defendant in order to allow the latter to pay his fines over a period of time or to perform community service work.
- If no payment is received from the defendant within the allotted time, the Fine Collector may apply other recovery measures, such as garnishing wages or seizing property (automobile, furniture, bank account, etc.).
- If these other recovery measures fail, the Fine Collector may ask the court to issue a warrant of imprisonment.
