It offers direct financial support to promote the training and implementation of best practices in human resource management and optimize the operation of businesses and the labor market. Normal business activities must have been affected by the COVID-19 pandemic, whether by suspension, decline, increase or diversification of activity



Eligible Promoters

- Employers
- Self-employed workers Professional groups Employer groups
- Regional organizations
- Cooperatives
- Social economy enterprises
- Non-profit organizations,
- Etc.



Eligible expenses

- Professional fees for consultants or trainers
- Indirect costs for trainers
- Teaching materials
- Training Content
- The equipment/supplies for specific activities
- Converting live trainings to online trainings
- Platform registration fees
- Etc.



Financial assistance:

- Reimbursement of eligible expenses
- 100% of expenses of \$100,000 or less
- 50% of expenses over \$100,000 and below \$200,000
- 25% of expense over \$200,000 up to \$500,000



Projects will be accepted until December 11, 2020, or until the \$1 million budget envelope is exhausted. The training or human resources management projects submitted can be of variable duration (from a few days to a few weeks or months) depending on the needs established.
