Northern Village of Inukjuak Provides Update on Critical Incident Investigation

Inukjuak, Québec – December 22, 2025 – The Northern Village of Inukjuak is providing an update following the serious incident that occurred in the community on December 20, 2025.

The following is a statement from the Mayor of Inukjuak:

"I have spoken with the **Interim Chief of Police, the Chairperson of the Kativik Regional Government (KRG)**.

The 6-year-old girl was immediately medevaced and is currently receiving care at the Montreal Children's Hospital. Unfortunately, it remains not my place to comment on her condition or the condition of the man involved, as this is a matter of medical privacy.

The **Kativik Regional Government (KRG)** has continued to offer resources and support to our community.

Investigation Update

The BEI and the Sûreté du Québec (SQ) investigators have concluded gathering evidence on-site here in Inukjuak. The focus of the investigation now shifts to the technical phase. The BEI, who was assisted by a ballistics specialist from the Laboratory of Forensic Science and Legal Medicine **and the SQ will need to conduct further analysis** to advance the investigation into the incident that involved a man in his 30s and a 6-year-old girl.

I extend my deep support to the family of the young girl and to all community members affected by this distressing event. We remain committed to cooperating fully with the investigating authorities.
