





Employment Rate, Inuit Population of Nunavik and Total of On-Reserve First Nations Populations, Per Cent 2011





Unemployment Rate, Inuit Population of Nunavik and Total of On-Reserve First Nations Populations, Per Cent 2011





Labour Force Participation Rate, Total Population of Canada, and Inuit Population of Nunavik, Per Cent 1996-2011




Labour Force Participation Rate, Inuit Population of Nunavik and Total of On-Reserve First Nations Populations, Per Cent 2011
















Age-Standardized Mortality Rate Per 100,000 Population by Region, Inuit Nunangat, Total Population, 1994-2008

Rate of Places Per 100 Children Aged 0-4 Years, 2014




