FIELDWORK ACTIVITIES ON THE UNORGANIZED TERRITORY

The Unorganized Territory (UT) of Nunavik, is defined as the territory beyond Northern Villages boundaries, it covers roughly 500 000 km². On that immense territory, the Kativik Regional Government act as a municipality. The KRG Civil Security Department in collaboration with the KRG Environment and Land section have established a short form destined to all Fieldwork Activities organizers that occur on the unorganized territory.

This form is intended to gather simple information on Fieldwork Activities that could be helpful in case of an emergency.

It is also intended to raise awareness to all Fieldwork activity organizer or promoter about the inherent risk that they assume by doing their project on the unorganized territory.

According to articles 5 and 6 of the *Civil Protection Act*:

"5. All persons must exercise prudence and foresight with regard to major or minor disaster risks they know to be present in their environment.

6. Any person who settles on a site where occupation of the land is commonly known to be subject to special restrictions by reason of a major or minor disaster risk without abiding by such restrictions is presumed to accept the risk involved." (Civil Protection Act, 2001, c. 76, s. 5 and 6).

To that end, we required that Fieldwork Activities organizers fill the following form and provide indication of having established an emergency plan for their activities.
